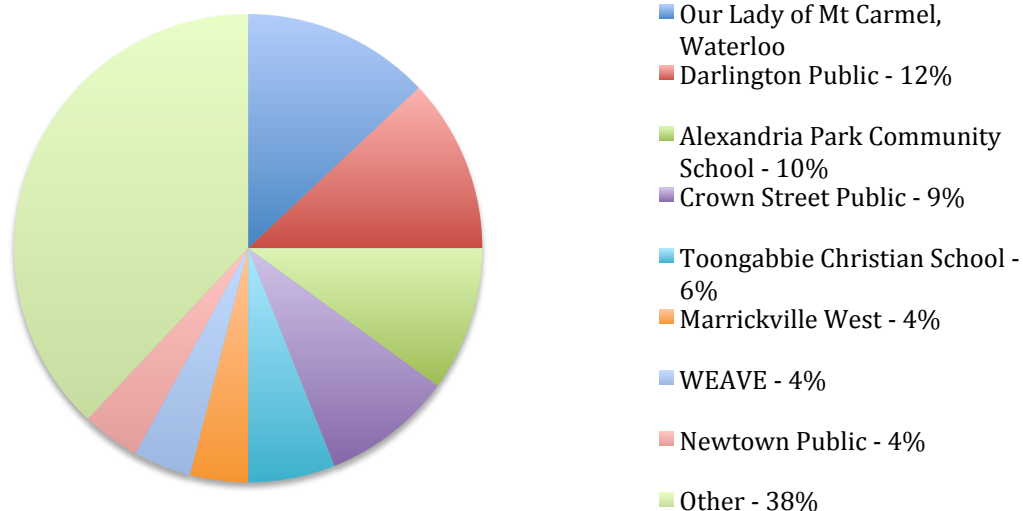

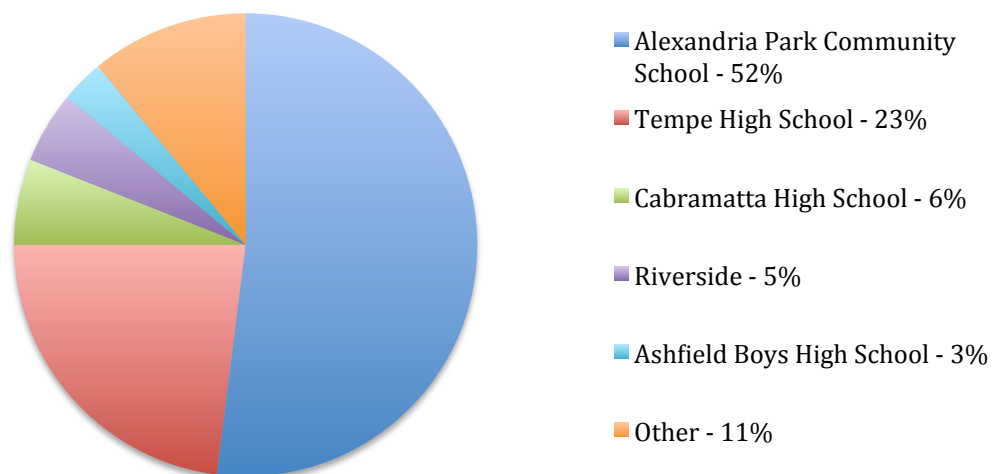
SCHOOL PARTICIPATION RATES – JULY 2012-APRIL 2013
