OGRE-IFFIC RECIPES

Barbecued Armadillo Shell Recipe

"A tender delicacy specially for Ogres" (Serves 2-3 Ogres)

Ingredients:

2X plump armadillo's shell 3X tbsp Cajun pepper 2X garlic cloves Salt Canola Oil 15X thyme leaves

Instructions:

- 1. Boil the shell in 1.2L of hot water. (125 degrees Celsius). Do this until shell appears faintly transparent.
- 2. Once boiled well, begin blending the thyme leaves with 2 tablespoons of canola oil. After approximately 3 minutes of blending, your thyme should of been transformed into a consistent paste.
- 3. Rub the thyme paste on to the shell, making sure that you do not miss any parts.
- 4. Begin crushing the cloves of garlic and after that, sprinkle the

Cajun pepper over the shell.

- 5. Place the crushed garlic cloves on to your barbecue alongside the armadillo shell.
- 6. Commence the barbecuing!
- 7. Remember to pour a few millilitres of canola oil once every five minutes for twenty minutes, which is the time your armadillo shell should be barbecued for.

Optional: Serve with Shitaki mushrooms

Badger Blubber Dip

"A thick and creamy dip made from the fat of undomesticated badgers" (Serves 3-4 Ogres)

Ingredients:

125g badger blubber 30g sour cream 2X egg whites, beaten 7X dill pickles, chopped 15ml hot sauce

Instructions:

Blend all the ingredients together until smooth.

Optional: Serve with nachos of your choice.

So how about the waters around Thank you for today. **Australia, who are they managed** Not a problem. Any time.




