We're offering you an empowering and engaging workshop that will bring your colleagues together to transcribe our students' work. You and your colleagues will gain a glimpse into the vibrant imaginations of young people from under-resourced communities and start to better understand your own and each others' creativity.

As a team, in your 1.5 hour workshop, either in person or virtually, you will:

- be inspired by our Story Factory staff with an introductory presentation as they share stories about the amazing young people we work with,
- unlock your own creativity with a fun and easy facilitated creativity activity suitable for your most reticent colleagues, and
- directly help several young people with their own creativity by transcribing their hand written stories and providing some words of encouragement.

Key to Story Factory programs is that all students write something and have it published! However we work with over 6,000 kids a year so that means it's a mammoth task to type up all the students' great work. That's where you and your workmates step in.

With the help of a Story Factory facilitator, you'll be given several students' handwritten stories to type up. You'll also be guided to offer the students some words of encouragement about their writing - words that will spur them on to write an even better story.

Our Storytellers will then take these transcriptions and words of encouragement back to the students, who will draw on them to create the final version of their story. These stories will be published in a handsomely-bound book, given to every member of their class.

After the workshop you'll come away with a shared team experience that is sure to leave you all with a warm glow knowing that you've directly helped young people tell their stories.




Image: Iress staff participating in a Story Factory virtual transcription workshop
